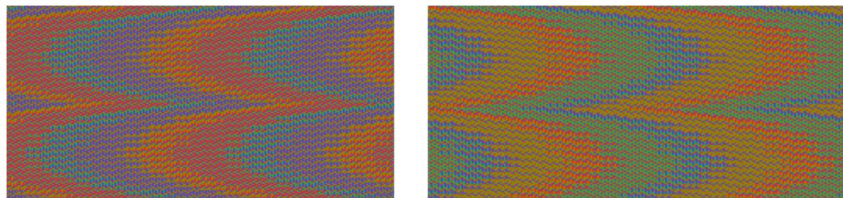
Hello Weavers!
